TORMEAD COACH SERVICE

Our coach service provides pupils and parents with a convenient, safe, reliable and environmentally friendly means of transport to and from school. Many of our existing passengers have used the service since their first day at Tormead and will continue to do so until their last, finding it a great way to meet and make friends from across the school.

We currently operate eight routes covering areas including Camberley, Cobham, Esher, Ewhurst, Farnham, Haslemere, Peaslake and Weybridge.

How much does it cost?

Pass type		Fees 2017/2018
Full Time Pass	Return journeys, five days a week	£365 per term
AM/PM Only Pass	Either: - five mornings or five afternoons or - a combination of mornings and afternoons, not exceeding five single journeys per week	£260 per term
Adhoc Tickets	'On the day' journeys bought from the school office	£3.20 single £6.40 return

Fare discounts

The following discounts are available to full time and AM/PM only passes:

Study leave: a reduction of 50% applied to summer term fees for Year 11/13 students.
a reduction of 30% applied to summer term fees for Year 12 students.

Sibling: a reduction of 20% for the 2nd child and 33% for the 3rd child.

After school club: a reduction of 20% applied to termly coach fees.

Commitment and notice periods

Our terms and conditions require a full terms notice in writing or a terms fees will become payable in lieu. Exceptions will be considered if a child leaves school or they move to an area not covered by the coach services.

How do I purchase a pass?

Seats can be booked via our online booking form www.tormeadschool.org.uk/schoolcoachservice. We will endeavour to accommodate all requests for places, however where space is limited those requiring full time tickets and travelling the furthest will be given priority.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Coach Passes

Coach passes are issued termly and checked on a regular basis by the Coach Stewards. The passes ensure that the school is aware of who is travelling on the coaches.

Who can use the coach service?

The service is open to pupils of all ages once they have settled into school life although we recommend Reception parents bring their children in for the first half term.

What supervision is provided on the coach?

Each coach route has at least one Coach Steward*; an appointed member of the Senior School. The Coach Stewards provide a vital link with the School and the School Coach Coordinator. Their role is to highlight any issues with girls' safety and wellbeing, promote the coach code of conduct and provide feedback on timings and routing issues.

Pupils and parents are also asked to agree to and abide by the coach code of conduct when they book a seat online. Parents are responsible for making provision for the supervision of their daughters once they leave the coaches in the afternoons at their designated stop.

**Due to the size of vehicle and number of passengers the Ewhurst route does not currently have a coach steward.*

Who looks after Junior School pupils?

Our Coach Stewards help with the safety and well being of all passengers and we ask that they keep a special eye on younger pupils. Coach Stewards ensure that everyone is seated and able to use their seat belt. Junior School pupils are escorted to and from the school coaches by members of staff. Special arrangements are made for Junior School pupils between the end of the school day and the coach departure time.

Can siblings from other Guildford schools use the coach?

Our coach service accepts bookings from Lanesborough Preparatory School pupils. Sibling discounts apply.

Can the coach route/times be altered?

We regularly appraise our routes and may make slight amendments subject to pupil demand and school requirements on an annual basis.
